Notable – BFA President, Shields Trauger Award

Pat Barz received the Balloon Federation of America highest award, the Shields Trauger Award. Following is a portion of the July 24, 1992 nomination letter from Jewel Cutter and the list of accomplishments that accompanied the nomination.

"... It is hard to summarize Pat's contributions as they are considerable. I will try to highlight for you.

She has been active in ballooning for 19 years, participating in every phase possible from crewing to instructing. She has worked in one position or another at the Nationals for 17 years including observer, debriefer, assistant launch director, assistant competition task sitter, and chief debriefer.

Pat has served on the regular BFA Board of Directors for six years as Secretary of the BFA Board in 1982 and 1983 and President of the Board in 1984. Pat helped organize the first BFA Convention held in 1977 in Reno, Nevada.

Pat has also served at the international level at the 1st championships as a debriefer, North Americans as a debriefer and at Battle Creek, and on the jury at the US National level.

For the last five years Pat has served on the BFA CD Division Board. She has been Secretary for the last 4 years and editor of the CD newsletter.
