## ED YOST MASTER PILOT AWARD

CANDIDATE: Robert (Rob) Bartholomew (1974-2014/current)

Rob Bartholomew's experience began in 1966 when he received his pilot license for Airplane Single Engine Land. On April 8, 1974 he completed his Hot Air Balloon "solo flight" and received his Commercial Lighter than Air Free Balloon License on May 1, 1974. Rob's aviation experience continued through the years; in 1978 he became (and is still currently) a Federal Aviation Administration Designated Examiner, opened (and still operates) a Federal Aviation Administration Certified Repair Station, and became a Federal Aviation Administration Prevention Counselor. In 1986, Rob became a Federal Aviation Administration Certified 141 Flight School Chief Instructor.

Along with aviation experience, Rob has served on or been a member of the following organizations: Balloon Federation of America (since 1974), Balloon Federation of America Board of Directors for the North Central Region of the United States (Secretary 1985-1986, board member 1985-1987), National Balloon Classic board member, founding father of Balloons Over Iowa (1979 – current, which still holds ground school once a year), and the Iowa Balloonist Association.

Through the years of ballooning and competing, Rob has received a number of awards and championship titles:
