Following are remarks made at the Alabama Jubilee Balloon Event upon the presentation of the Ed Yost Master Pilot award to Rocky.

Rocky is being presented the Ed Yost Master Pilot Award from the BFA recognizing his efforts as a lighter than air pilot who has maintained safe flight operations for 40 consecutive years or more.

Purpose of the award is to recognize LTA pilots who have demonstrated professionalism, skill and aviation expertise by maintaining safe operations for 40 or more consecutive years as active pilots. Rocky has flown continuously throughout his 42 years as a lighter than air pilot.

Rocky received his LTA commercial certificate in 1972. Karl Stefan was his instructor. Rocky was awarded the Balloon Federation of America's highest award, the Shields Trauger Award in 1989 for his efforts in the BFA Instructor programs.

While he has achieved ratings in just about everything there is to fly and receive a rating in and has had an incredible far reaching aviation career, ballooning has always been, and continues to be, his first passion.
