Notable – Accomplishments/Contributions

Born March 17, 1948 in Shreveport, Louisiana and remained a lifelong resident of Louisiana. I received a Bachelor's degree in business from Northeast Louisiana University and a Master's degree in Business from Centenary College of Louisiana.

I owned three businesses, selling each prior to my 50th birthday and retired from official work in March 1998. I have been flying hot air balloons ever since. Acquiring my private LTA license in the fall of 1990 and my commercial ticket in the spring

of 1991, I currently have 3,200+ pilot-in-command hours.

Notable championships include four (4) Louisiana State Championships, two (2) Oklahoma State Championships, one (1) Texas State Championships and two (2) BFA Southeast Regional Championships. I was elected Chairman of the Board of the Red River Balloon Rally from 1991 until 2003.

My wife (Susan Harwell) and I set the US and World record for distance flown in an AX-4 (31,000 cu. ft.) balloon with an airborne heater totaling (139.71 miles – mine and 47.01 miles – hers) in March 1998.

From 2000 – 2003, I served on the Board of Directors of the Balloon Federation of America.

I provided successful flight instruction for 24 students to completion of their LTA licenses while the owner/operator of American Escapes Aerosports in Shreveport, Louisiana (since 1991). We now specialize in commercial rides, tether operations, flight instruction, and balloon event organization for southern communities.
