Started Crewing for the Don & Nikki Caplan Family in the Fall of 1978 at The Great Forest Park Balloon Race St. Louis, Missouri. After Almost Two Years crewing and Maintaining Hot Air Balloon equipment for the Balloon Port Of St. Louis under the Direct Supervision of Natalie J. Nikki Caplan. I was sent for Repairman Training to Both The Balloon Works Statesville NC and to Sky Power in Tea South Dakota under the supervision of the Legendary Ed Yost.

After Numerous Ground schools with The Caplans and with Mr. Bob Esch of Edwardsville, Illinois I was Kicked from the nest at Balloon Port and Began my Training under Donald J. Caplan -Nikki Caplan and Mike Ledbetter & Russell Pickthall along with C. Jane Buckles and Lyndell Buckles.

After several False starts with Logbook and Student Licenses and Informal Training when Balloon Flight(s) were canceled due to it being too windy for Passengers, I was trained by one of the best at the Time, Mr. Don Caplan.
